By Whom Was the World Created?

Genesis 1:1:

"In the beginning Eloah created the heaven and the earth."

Was Anyone associated with Eloah in the work of Creation?

Genesis 1:26;

"And Eloah said, 'Let us make man in our image, after our likeness."

Who was with El in the work of Creation?

John 1:1-3;

"In the Beginning was the Word... The same was in the beginning with El. All things were made by him." (the Word was & is Messias, John 1:14/etc.).

John 1:10;

"He was in the world & the world was made by him."

Hebrews 1:1-2;

"El... hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son... by whom also He made the worlds."

Colossians 1:16;

"For by him (the Son of El) were all things created."

Ephesians 3:9;

"El, who created all things by Yahshua Messias."

How was the World Created?

Hebrews 11:3;

"The worlds were framed by the Word of El.".

Psalm 33:6;

"By the Word of YHWH were the heavens made."

Psalm 33:9;

"He Spake, and it was done."

How long did it take to create the Earth?

"In six days Yahweh made heaven and earth."

from the Garden of Eden. "So He drove out the man."

El said, "Thou shalt surely die."

"In this was manifested the love of El toward us, because that El sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him."

"Hereby perceive we the Love of Eloah, because Messias laid down his life for us."

"Herein is Love, not that we loved Eloah, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

Which is the Sabbath Day?

Exodus 20:10;

"The Seventh Day is the Sabbath."

Why was the Seventh Day Chosen?

Genesis 2:3;

"And El blessed the Seventh Day, and sanctified it; because that in it He had rested from all His work."

Who Rested on that Day?

Hebrews 1:2:

Ephesians 3:9; John 1:1-3/14;

Elohim, for Elohim created all things.

What does Messias say that he is?

Mark 2:27-28;

"Lord (Master) of the Sabbath."

Of what is the Sabbath, a sign?

Ezekiel 20:12;

First, a sign of sanctification.

Second, a sign by which we may know Eloah. verse

What Does the Sabbath Remain?

Exodus 31:16;

"a perpetual Covenant."

How will the redeemed regard the Sabbath? *Isaiab* 66:22-23:

They will keep it in the New Earth.

Sabbath Keeping Examples:

What day did Yahshua keep?

Luke 4:16;

"Yahshua, 'as his custom was,... went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read." ('twas the same Sabbath the Jews were keeping. See Matthew 12:10-13; and Luke 13:14-15).

What day did Paul observe?

Acts 17:2;

"And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and *in* three Sabbath days, reasoned with them out of the scriptures."

What day did others keep?

Luke 23:56;

II.

The women "prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath day according to the Command-ment." (this was also the 7th day: Luke 24:1/Matthew 28:1).

When does the Sabbath begin?

Leviticus 23:32;

Nehemiah 13:19; "From evening unto evening, shall ye celebrate your Sabbath." (sunset to sunset).

Who is our example?

1 John 2:6;

"He that saith he abideth in Messias ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked."

State of the Dead:

How do the Scriptures speak of the Dead?

1 Thessalonians 4:13;

"I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep."

Also, Psalm 13:3

John 11:11-13.

Can the dead praise Eloah?

Psalm 115:17;

No, they are silent.

Are the dead conscious?

Psalm 6:5;

12.

"In death there is no remembrance of Thee."

What happens to their thoughts?

Psalm 146:4;

They perish.

Have they any part in anything that is done?

Ecclesiastes 9:4-6, 10;

No, they sleep 'til the Resurrection.

Does man's estate in death differ from the animals?

Ecclesiastes 3:19-21;

...No, they all have one breath.

What Becomes of the Dead?

To what did David look forward?

To the Resurrection:

Psalm 17:15;

"I shall be satisfied when I awaken with Thy likeness."

Psalms 146:2&4;

Genesis 3:19;

In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, til thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken; for dust thou art and unto dust shalt thou return. Job 14:12 & 21;

Job 17:16;

Eccl. 3:20;

Eccl. 9:5-6 & 11;

Daniel 12:2;

John 11:1-4; (death as sleep) *6:5;*

Acts 2:29; David still in sheol/grave...

1 Cor. 15:18-20;

Had he awakened in the apostles' day?

Acts 2:29; 13:36; 2:34;

No, he still slept... (???).

Will both the righteous (by faith) and the wicked awaken/arise?

John 5:28-29;

Yes, Messias promised **all** of us a resurrection.

When will the righteous-by-faith awaken/arise?

1 Corinthians 15:51-55;

At the "last trump."

1 **Thessalonians 4:16;** At Messias' call.

Job 14:14-15; 19:25-27;

When Messias returns.

When will the wicked arise?

Revelation 20:5;

At the end of the 1000 yrs.

What will be their lot?

Romans 6:23;

The wages of sin is death.

Revelation 20:6/2:11/20:14;

Yah calls it the "Second Death."

What will remain of the wicked (Impenitent)?

Malachi 4:1-3;

Psalm 37:10,20;

Ashes and Smoke:...

Revelation 14:11;

And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever, and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark **of his name**.

When Are the Rewards Given?

"For the Son of Man shall come; ...and then he shall reward every man according to his works."

Revelation 22:12;

"...behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be." (works of faith).

In what do they consist?

1 Corinthians 9:25;

An incorruptible crown.

1 Peter 5:4;

A crown of glory.

2 Timothy 4:8;

A crown of righteousness.

James 1:12; Revelation 2:10;

A crown of Life.

1 John 2:25;

Eternal Life.

2 Peter 3:13 Isaiah 65:17-25

Rev. 21:

A New Earth.

The Home of the Saved:

Where will the redeemed/elect dwell?

2 Peter 3:13

Rev.21:1

Isaiah 65:17;

In new heavens and a new earth.

Will sin ever enter there?

Nahum 1:9;

No, for "affliction shall not rise up the second time"

Will disease be known there?

Isaiah 33:24;

"The Inhabitant shall not say, I am sick."

Will sorrow be known there?

Revelation 21:4;

"Eloah will wipe away all tears from their eyes."

What will the dwellers there, do?

Isaiah 65:21;

They will build and plant.

Whose throne will be in the capital city?

Revelation 22:3;

The Throne of Eloah and Messias:

What does Paul say concerning the new earth? *I Corinthians 2:9*;

"Eye hath not seen nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which El hath prepared for them that love Him."

Yah give you Life Eternal in Messias Yahshua!
